**TAX RETURN SPECIALISTS AUTHORIZATION FOR THE ELECTRONIC FILING  
 AND DIGITAL SIGNATURE OF THE INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX RETURN**

Section 1061.01 of the Puerto Rico Internal Revenue Code of 2011, as amended, establishes the obligation to file an Individual Income Tax Return and allows it to be authenticated by digital signature. The taxpayer who wants to appoint a Tax Returns, Statements or Refund Claims Specialist (Specialist) to sign the return in digital form on his/her behalf shall complete this form and provide it to the Specialist along with copy of his/her driver's license or passport.
