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Glossary

Term	Definition
ACAA	- Automobile Accident Compensation Administration, or Administración de Compensaciones por Accidentes de Automoviles, is a component unit of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
Act 154	- Act 154 means Act No. 154-2010, which, inter alia, imposes a temporary excise tax on the acquisition by multinationals of certain property manufactured or produced in whole or in part in Puerto Rico and on the acquisition of certain manufacturing services carried out in Puerto Rico. The Act 154 temporary excise tax expires on December 31, 2027.
AFI / PRIFA	- Infrastructure Financing Authority.
ASC	- Compulsory Liability Insurance, private insurance company.
ASES	Puerto Rico Health Insurance Administration, a public corporation and component unit of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
CINE	- Puerto Rico Cinema Fund, a recipient of certain assigned sales and use tax revenues.
COFINA	- Puerto Rico Sales Tax Financing Corporation.
DTPR	- Department of the Treasury of Puerto Rico also referred to as "Hacienda".
DTPR Collection System	- This is the software system that DTPR uses for collections.
FAM	- Municipal Fund Administration, a recipient of certain assigned sales and use tax revenues.
General Fund Collections	- All gross tax collections received and deposited into the TSA from all Hacienda Collection Posts, through the Hacienda Colecturia Virtual (online), and/or SURI, as well as certain pass-through collections and others.
General Fund	- General Fund (Operating Fund) means the Commonwealth principal operating fund; disbursements from such fund are generally approved through the Commonwealth's annual budgeting process.
Gross Payroll	- Gross Payroll is equal to the sum of: (i) Net Payroll from the DTPR RHUM system; (ii) Other Payroll and (iii) Cash outlays for wage garnishments by Agency.
HTA	- Puerto Rico Highways and Transportation Authority, a public corporation and a component unit of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
Liquidity Plan (LP)	- The Liquidity Plan is the translation of the Certified Fiscal Plan ("CFP") and Certified Budget ("Budget") into a cash flow projection. The TSA Liquidity Plan encompasses all cash flow activity within the TSA. Certain cash flow activity is contemplated in the CFP and Budget, but occurs outside the TSA. Cash flow bridges from the TSA to the CFP and Budget have been included to facilitate comparison.
NAP	- NAP, or the Nutrition Assistance Program, also known as PAN, or Programa de Asistencia Nutricional is a federal assistance nutritional program provided by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) solely to Puerto Rico.
ОМВ	- The Office of Management and Budget of Puerto Rico.
Other Payroll	- Other Payroll expenses relate to employee withholdings, social security, insurance, and other deductions.
Other State Collections	- Inflows related to various Health Department programs, the State Insurance Fund, the Commissioner of Financial Institutions, interest earned on TSA bank accounts and others.
РауGo	- PayGo - Puerto Rico pension system that is funded through a pay-as-you-go system. Retirement benefits expenses of government employers are paid by the central government and reimbursed by the employers, with such funds received by the TSA.
Plan of Adjustment ("Plan")	- Plan to adjust the liabilities for the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Puerto Rico Public Building Authority, and Employee Retirement System of the Government of Puerto Rico confirmed on 1/18/22 by the US District Court for the District of Puerto Rico under PROMESA.
PREPA	- Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority, a public corporation and a component unit of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
PRITA	- Puerto Rico Integrated Transport Authority, a public corporation and component unit of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
PSTBA	- The PSTBA is an amount established under Act 91-2006, as amended, and the Sales Tax Revenue Bond Resolution, as amended and restated on June 10, 2009 (the "Bond Resolution"), that currently must be received by COFINA from 5.5% of the SUT before the Commonwealth can receive any of the other 5.5% SUT.
Public Corporation	- Public corporations are governmental authorities with autonomous structure separate from the central government administration and with independent treasury functions.
RHUM System	- This is the software system that DTPR uses for payroll.
SIFC	State Insurance Fund Corporation, a public corporation and a component unit of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
Special Revenue Receipts	- Collections made by central government agencies at collection posts for services rendered by the agencies as well as fees, licenses, permits, fines and others.
SURI	- Sistema Unificado de Rentas Internas is the new digital tool of the Department of the Treasury that will allow integration and streamlining of the administration of taxes and revenues and eliminate the complexity of the current systems for the benefit of the Treasury and the taxpayers.
SURI Sweep Account Transfers	- The SURI Sweep Account balance transfers is included as part of the General Fund Collections.
TSA	- Treasury Single Account, the Commonwealth's main operational bank account (concentration account) in which a majority of receipts from Governmental funds are deposited and from which most expenses are disbursed. TSA receipts include tax collections, charges for services, intergovernmental collections, the proceeds of short and long-term debt issuances and amounts held in custody by the Secretary of the Treasury for the benefit of the Commonwealth's fiduciary funds. Only a portion of the revenues received by the TSA is included in the annual General Fund budget presented to the Puerto Rico Legislative Assembly for approval. Other revenues are separately assigned by law to certain agencies or public corporations but still flow through the TSA.

Introduction

- Enclosed is the weekly Treasury Single Account ("TSA") cash flow report and supporting schedules with weekly YTD FY2024 actual results compared to the FY2024 Liquidity Plan.
- TSA is the Commonwealth's main operational bank account (concentration account) in which a majority of receipts from Governmental funds are deposited and from which most expenses are disbursed.
- Receipts in the TSA include tax collections (including revenues assigned to certain public corporations and pledged for the payment of their debt service), charges for services, intergovernmental collections (such as reimbursements from Federal assistance grants), the proceeds of short and long-term debt issuances held in custody by the Secretary of Treasury for the benefit of the Government fiduciary funds, and other receipts. Only a portion of the revenues received by the TSA is included in the annual General Fund budget presented to the Puerto Rico Legislative Assembly for approval. Other revenues are separately assigned by law to certain agencies or public corporations but still flow through the TSA.
- Disbursements from the TSA include payroll and related costs, vendor and operational disbursements (including those reimbursed by Federal assistance grants and funded from Special Revenue Funds), welfare expenditures, capital outlays, debt service payments, required budgetary formulas and appropriation payments, pass-through payments of pledged revenues to certain public corporations, tax refunds, payments of current pension benefits and other disbursements.
- Federal funds related to disaster relief for hurricanes Irma and Maria are deposited in a separate bank account overseen by the Government Authorized Representative ("GAR"). Funds may be transferred to the TSA either: (i) after admissible disbursements (per approved Project Worksheets) have been made or (ii) once supporting documentation for an accrual or related expense are provided to and approved by FEMA. Therefore, FEMA funding may also be received in advance of actual cash disbursement, as payments to vendors may occur subsequent to when the corresponding services are rendered / expenses are recorded.
- Data limitations and commentary:

The government has focused on cash transaction information for which access to reliable, timely, and detailed data is readily available. The government continues to work with DTPR and other parties to access additional reliable data that would help to provide additional detail in the future.

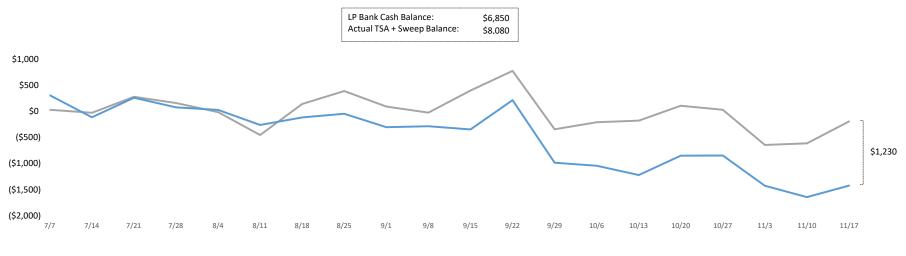

----- Net YTD Actual Cumulative Cash Flow ----- LP YTD Cumulative Cash Flow

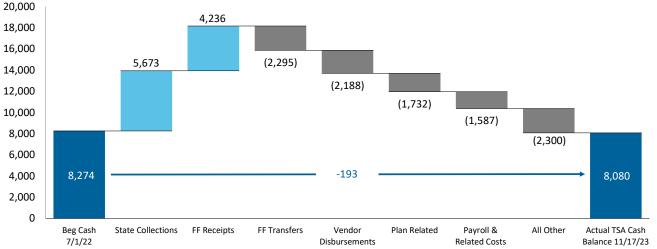

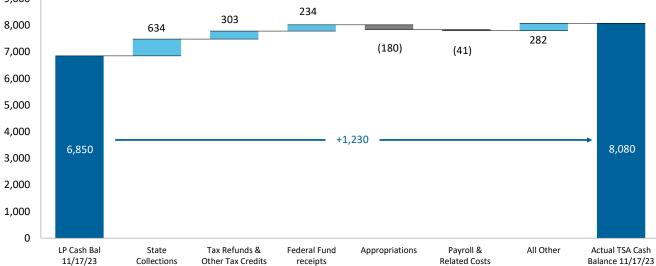
Net Cash Flow - YTD Actuals

Federal Fund inflows of \$4,236M represent 42% of YTD inflows, but are largely offset by Federal Fund transfers, with YTD net surplus of \$230M (Refer to page 13 for additional detail).

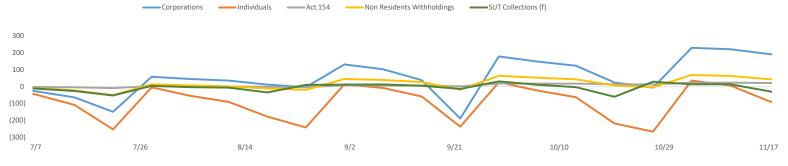

- (a) Represents gross tax collections received and deposited from all Hacienda Collection Posts, through the Hacienda Colecturia Virtual (online) and/or SURI. Additionally, as of the date of this report, the "General Fund Collections" line item includes unreconciled collections due to DTPR transition to collecting various gross tax receipts through SURI system. The SURI Sweep Account balance transfers is included as part of the General Fund Collections.
- (b) These revenues are collected by DTPR and immediately appropriated.
- (c) Inflows related to the State Insurance Fund, the Department of Labor and Human Resources, the Commissioner of Financial Institutions, interest earned on TSA bank accounts and others. As of the date this report the TSA has received \$149.3M in interest income in FY24 from earnings on the TSA cash balance.
- (d) Transfer of CRIM portion pursuant to the POA. CRIM shall pay to the Commonwealth amounts collected by CRIM in connection with the 1.03% property tax levied pursuant to Act 83-1991 and which are due and owing to the Commonwealth.
- (e) Represents total gross payroll. Gross payroll includes net payroll disbursed to government employees, cash transfers to the Police Department for payroll costs, and other payroll related costs (employee withholdings, social security, insurance, and other
- (f) Includes payments to third-party vendors as well as intergovernmental payments to agencies with separate Treasuries.
- (g) Includes Federally Funded Employee Retention Credits.
- (h) Funds are held in a separate bank account outside of the TSA Operational Cash. Some of these funds are not restricted, as defined by the Governmental Accounting Standard Board (GASB), but have been segregated by the Government for the service to the debt and the Disaster Relief Fund, among other purposes.

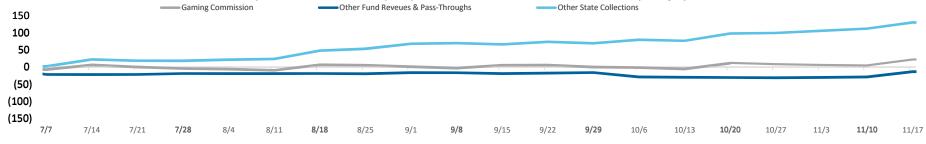

 Other State Fund Collections are higher than projected in the Liquidity Plan. The variance in Special Revenue Fund is mainly driven by timing differences. Other state collections variance is mainly driven by funds received by Gambling Commission of the Government of Puerto Rico being \$60M higher than projected and All Other Agencies being \$44M higher than expected.

YTD Other State Fund Receipts Cumulative Variance Liquidity Plan forecast vs. Actual Cumulative Variance by Category (\$M)

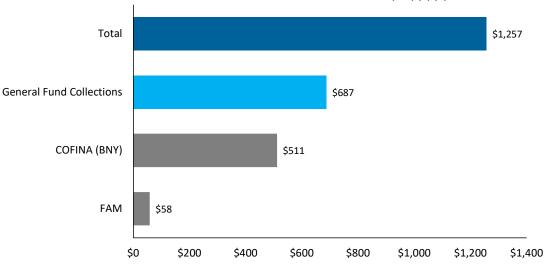


Other State Fund Collections Year to Date: Actual vs. Forecast (\$M)

 The proceeds from the Puerto Rico 10.5% SUT rate are allocated as follows: Of the 10.5%, 5.5% is deposited into a COFINA BNY Mellon account until the PSTBA cap is reached, and 4.5% is deposited into the General Fund. The remaining 0.5% is remitted to FAM.

(b) As of November 17, 2023 there is \$63M in SUT collected pending verification and allocation. The verification process includes matching receipts with the appropriate returns and reconciling government account information. Once this process is complete, SUT funds are distributed in accordance with the COFINA Plan of Adjustment based on the ownership of funds and otherwise based on the limits on distributions established therein.

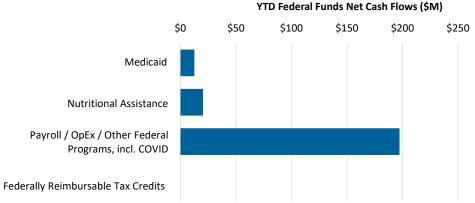

Key Takeaways / Notes

- Receipts for the Nutritional Assistance Program (NAP) and 1) Medicaid (ASES Pass-through) are received in advance of the subsequent pass through disbursements. Federal Funds received for Payroll and Vendor Payments are typically reimbursed following disbursement. There may be temporary week to week surplus / (deficit) due to timing differences. These funds are held in a separate account outside of TSA. Some of the measures funded by the accounts are initially paid out through TSA, and later reimbursed from the respective external account.
- 2) As of the date of the report, \$319M of reimbursements related to Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) and Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (CSLFRF) has been received and (\$258M) was disbursed and is reported as All Other Federal Funds Transfers; with a net cash flow of \$61M.
- The Federal Funds are currently higher than projected. The 3) positive YTD variance is mainly driven by All Other Federal Programs of \$87M, All Other Federal Funds of \$61M and lower than projected payroll and related costs of \$54M, partially offset by higher than projected operating disbursements of (\$98M).

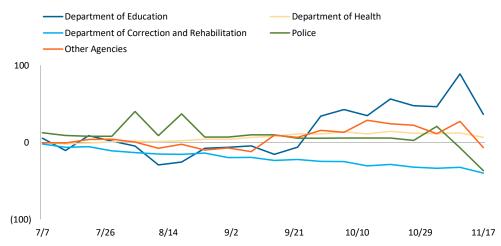

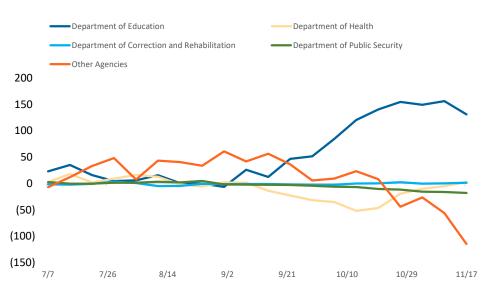

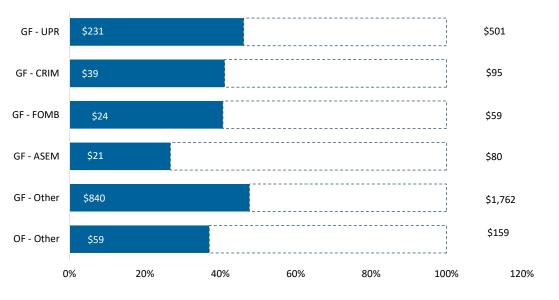

The amount transferred each month is usually the sum of the receiving entity's budgeted amount for FY24 divided into twelve, subject to a 2.5% holdback through the first nine months of the fiscal year, to be disbursed during the fourth quarter following reconciliation of General Fund revenues to Fiscal Plan projections and subsequent approval and authorization for release by the Oversight Board and the Director of FOMB. Other General Fund transfers and Other Fund transfers require the recognition of certain revenues within DTPR accounting records prior to sending funds to a receiving entity.

YTD PayGo Receipts and Retirement Contributions (\$M)

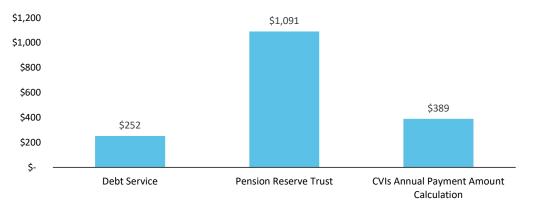
